Prsentation by Dr. Shreekant Diwan, Chairman, Indian Vinyl Council

GHMC REVENUE EMPLOYEES' WELFARE ASSOCIATION SUBMISSION TO THE COMMISSIONER, GHMC

The revenue employees of GHMC under the leadership of Association President Mr. Manda Ravi brought departmental issues to the Commissioner of GHMC.

In spite of efforts are being made for collection of property tax by the Revenue staff, the pension amounts are not getting in-time every month, as the pension amounts are being credited in the respective accounts between 4th to 10th of every month, which causes much inconvenience to the staff, thus it is requested to take immediate action in this regard, as the Service Pension amounts & Family pension amounts to be credited 1st of every month. 2) Further, it is bring to your kind notice that as there are number of Bill Collector posts are lying vacant, due to which the work is badly effecting on collection of revenue. It is proposed to post the staff venuse bers who have been working as Office Subordinates, Public Haan Workers (those who have passed SSC / 10th Class), these staff 20271 hers may kindly be posted as Bill Collectors, so that their Ser-

VICES may be used for collection of property tax. Further, it is bring to your kind notice that Office Subordinates, Public Health Workers, Kamatees who are discharging as Bill Collectors among them 80% are illiterate, since they could not able to attend the assigned duties i.e., serving of Notices U/s.213 in (4) categories i.e., 101 Properties, Zero Plinth area properties, Zero Demand properties, TGSPDCL-GHMC matching properties, Suo-Moto enhancements.

3) Further, it is to submit that, it is requested that please consider the serving of Notices U/s.213 in (4) categories i.e., 101 Properties, Zero Plinth area properties, Zero Demand properties, TGSPDCL-GHMC matching properties, Suo-Moto enhancements as "Ongoing work" and provide time atleast as One Year. Since previously also we have worked the above said work during the year 2015-2016. 4) It is to submit that while taking property tax review, if the Head Office Officials are issuing such Memos, the Tax Inspectors and Bill Collectors most

of the employees are facing Health problems i.e., High Blood Pressure, Diabetic and other Health issues, may effect their Health.

5) It is to submit that, inspite of many constraints we work with utmost elegance, karkoons, Office Sub-Ordinates, Public Health Workers and other lower cadre staff were forced to work as BCs and in-spite of which they have obeyed the instructions from the higher authorities and executing their duties. 6) Further, it is to submit that besides collection of property tax the services of Bill Collectors and Tax Inspectors were also being involved in many other activities such as Family Digital Card Survey, Election, Door to Door Survey etc and we will work without any hindrance in-spite of over burden. Besides as a part of our regular taxation works the list of properties with property tax as Rs.101/-, Zero Plinth Area (Suo-Moto), Zero Demand, TGPDSCL were provided to all circles for initiation action.

7) Further, it is to submit that even the Additional

Commissioner (Revenue), GHMC in her review meeting on 18-10-2024 is diverting DCs about poor performing BCs in Suo-Moto Enhancements and their supervision and directing BCs, TIs to complete the work in a short time. 8) Further, it is to submit that while submitting the Enhancement proposals under "Suo-moto Revisions", due to scanning the proposals it is taking a lot of time, thus, it is requested that kindly arrange to remove the "Scanning Option", so that Suo-moto Enhancements can done in a fast way. 9) Further, it is to submit that for preparation of Enhancement proposals, due to shortage of Stationery papers, causing much inconvenience and also in most of the Circles, there is problem of Refilling of Cartridges, due to which the delay of preparation of Enhancement proposals are occurred. Hence, it is requested that kindly arrange to provide sufficient Stationery Papers and also it is requested to provide Refilling of Cartridges as and when required as per the emergency.
